WSCA Legislative Update

As the Legislature prepares to head into week 5 of the 2023 legislative session, committee agendas have fewer work sessions and more executive sessions, meaning the Chairs are deciding which bills to vote out of committee and on to the next stage of the legislative process. Typically, as the get closer to the committee deadline (February 17), legislators would be introducing fewer bills. Although numbers are beginning to dwindle, there are still a lot of new ideas being introduced every day. After the February 17th deadline for policy committees, and the subsequent fiscal committee cutoff a week later, the universe of bills is likely to get significantly smaller.

WSCA sent a letter to members of the House Education Committee expressing concerns about HB 1479, prohibiting the use of restraints and isolation for students in schools. Although WSCA supports the intent of the legislation, there are concerns with specific language in the bill that could affect school safety. WSCA has reached out to the bill's sponsor, Rep. Lisa Callan, and expressed an interest in working to improve the bill.

The Senate Early Learning & K-12 Education Committee passed SB 5339, legislation to provide universal free meals to students. The bill, which carries an \$87 million price tag, was referred to Senate Ways & Means. The vote out of committee split among party lines, with Democrats voting yes and Republicans voting no, or "without recommendation." The House version, HB 1238, was scheduled for a vote in House Education last week but did not come up.
